INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

What GREENFORCE LAWN WEEDKILLER does:
Controls most major lawn weeds including clover.

When to use: For use on lawns. Use from Spring (April) to September on lawns that are actively growing.

Directions for Use: Do not apply during windy conditions so that spray does not drift onto other plants.

Method of Application: Use a clean knapsack or watering can fitted with a fine rose. Mix well before use. Loosen Measure Cap slightly, gently squeeze bottle until required volume is achieved. Apply GREENFORCE LAWN WEEDKILLER at rate of:

50 ml in 2.5 - 5 ltrs of water to cover 25m² covering vegetation evenly. Re-treatment may be necessary for well established difficult to control weeds. Allow an interval of at least 6 weeks between treatments. Wash equipment thoroughly after use.

NOTE: DO NOT USE ON NEW-SOWN LAWNS FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS AFTER ESTABLISHMENT.

How to get the best results from GREENFORCE LAWN WEEDKILLER:
For maximum effect spray when the weeds have adequate leaf area to absorb the chemical. Apply when weeds are actively growing and soil is moist. Following spraying, do not cut grass for at least one day after treatment and ideally leave the sprayed area uncut for as long as practicable, to allow the chemical sufficient action to be translocated from the leaf and throughout the plant to the roots. Control may be reduced if rain falls within 24 hours of application.

Disposal of Lawn Clippings: The first four mowing of treated grass must be composted for six months before use as a mulch. GREENFORCE LAWN WEEDKILLER must not be used for purposes or in a manner not provided for on the label. Protect from frost. Wash hands after use.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Protection during/in use:
Use only in well-ventilated areas.

Environmental protection:
Do not contaminate ponds, streams, waterways or ditches with chemical or used container.

Do not contaminate water with the product or its container. Do not clean application equipment near surface water.

Avoid contamination via drains from farmyards and roads. Direct spray away from ponds and other surface water bodies.

Storage & disposal:
KEEP PRODUCT IN ORIGINAL CONTAINER, tightly closed, in a safe place.

IRELAND Only: To triple rinse empty container - open cap, with a blunt screwdriver, push plug into container and triple rinse in normal fashion.

UK Only: Dispose of unused product in its container at a household waste site (civic amenity site). Contact your local council (local authority) for details.

Dispose of empty container in the dustbin.

RISK & SAFETY INFORMATION

If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.

Keep out of reach of children. Read label before use.

Avoid breathing mist/spray. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

Dispose of contents/container to a licensed hazardous waste disposal contractor or collection site except for empty clean containers which can be disposed of as non-hazardous waste.

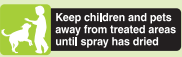
